Dear Chairman Graves and Ranking Member Larsen:

On behalf of the Travel Technology Association (Travel Tech) and our member companies, I write to express our support for H.R. 6086, the **Aviation Funding Solvency Act**, as the Committee considers the bill at its upcoming markup.

Travel Tech represents the leading Online Travel Agencies, Global Distribution Systems, metasearch platforms, and Travel Management Companies that help consumers compare, book, and manage air travel. These platforms are often the primary point of contact for travelers during disruptions, providing real-time information, rebooking assistance, and customer support when flights are delayed or canceled.

Past government shutdowns demonstrated how lapses in funding for Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) operations can disrupt air travel and place unnecessary strain on the aviation workforce, particularly air traffic controllers responsible for maintaining the safety and efficiency of the national airspace system. When FAA operations are affected, travelers experience cascading delays, cancellations, and uncertainty across the travel marketplace.

H.R. 6086 provides a targeted and responsible solution by allowing the FAA to maintain critical operations during a lapse in appropriations, while preserving appropriate fiscal safeguards. By prioritizing compensation for air traffic controllers and other safety-critical personnel, the bill helps ensure continuity of service and protects the traveling public from avoidable disruption during future shutdowns.



Travel Tech appreciates the Committee's bipartisan leadership on this practical, forward-looking approach to maintaining aviation system stability, and we urge the Committee to advance H.R. 6086.
